²Students who have had COMM 101 and decide to Major or Minor in Communication should NOT take COMM 201 but "pair" their 101 course with one of the following to meet the 201 requirement: Comm 221, 362 (2 hours), or 363.

COMM 301, Communication Theory, is required for Interpersonal Concentration and Media Concentrations

COMM 302, Rhetorical Theory, is required for Rhetoric and Theater Concentrations, and may be substituted with 301 for Media Concentration.

⁶ If possible, students should take their required Theory course prior to the required Research Methods course (exceptions may be granted for students whose schedules prevent this sequence). Each of the Research Methods courses are taught once per academic year and are as follows:

COMM 311 Communication Research, is required for Interpersonal Concentration and may be substituted with 312 for Media Concentration;

COMM 312 Communication Criticism, is required for Rhetoric, Theater, and Media Concentrations.

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⁷ All Communication majors are required to take 2 hours of Communication electives. In some situations, additional electives may be required to meet the 32 hour minimum for the major.

⁻There are many paths for Communication majors. Starting the major after freshman year is generally not a problem.
