

Health Professions Amsler Pre-Med Scholarship Spring 2025 - Information Sheet

The Amsler Pre-Med Scholarship was established by Wheaton College alumni Jean Amsler '59 and William Hoppel '59 in memory of Dr. Donald S. Amsler '58 and honor of Jean Amsler. The scholarship can be awarded to a single applicant or divided among recipients. In the past, 3 or 4 recipients were chosen. Recipients(s) shall be in their Junior or Senior year with high academic achievements and plan to attend medical school. Preference shall be given to students who plan to do Christian medical ministry either in the United States or abroad.

The following selection criteria will be used in determining qualified recipients:

- o Current sophomore or junior (in terms of years of college, not by credit hours)
- o Plan to attend medical school (allopathic or osteopathic)
- o Short Essays (no more than 250 words each)
- o List of Experiences (expanded resume)

How to Apply

1. Complete the online Health Professions Student Registration Form

2. Applicants are asked to submit the essay and expanded resume online

Respond to the following in no more than 250 words each:

- o Why are you pursuing a medical degree?
- Discuss how you see faith influencing or integrating into the practice of medicine? You could consider defining "Christian medical ministry" in your response.

The essay should demonstrate good writing skills. The essay must be 1 ½ or double spaced (not single spaced) and 11 or 12 pt. font.

Note: A copy of the recipient's responses will be given to the donor.

Expanded Resume:

This document aids the committee by providing a profile of your experiences (examples: volunteer and/or community service, research, shadowing/observation, employment, etc.). Please include the approximate hours (each week/month) for each experience. You are welcome to include activities that do not directly apply to medicine/healthcare. *Note: It can be longer than one page. Clear articulation of the responsibilities/skills of the experience is important.*
