Spiritual Theme of Voyageur:

- Theme verse is Colossians 1:15-23
- This year's theme for Voyageur is Shalom and Identity.
- Went through what shalom looks like in the four fundamental relationships we have: with God, with self, with others and with creation.
- Discovering their identity through how God sees them
- Highlighting how their identity helps them interact in community.
- Finished with what Paul writes in his letters of bringing shalom to others through having a Gospel identity.
