EVP of Finance and Operations (Provided by 2024-25 Temporary Constitution) A. Purpose.

- a. The Executive Vice President of Finance and Operations(EVPFO) shall assist the President and the Government in representing student concerns on matters related to technology, campus services, and finance, particularly the representation of stewardship and advancement on behalf of the student body to the administration. B. Executive Authority.
 - a. The EVPFO shall be the primary representative of Student Government with regards to issues of technology, campus services, and finance. As such, s/he shall chair the Finance and Operations Committee. The committee shall be comprised of any students the Executive Vice President may appoint. The EVPTCS shall have jurisdiction over issues such as the use of technology and college policy regarding technology, the Campus Store, CPO, dining, budgeting and spending, and any other such issues that the committee and the Government may wish the committee to pursue. Should any of these issues warrant the creation of an ad hoc Committee to deal specifically with a given issue, the Committee may request the creation of one with Government approval.

C. Government Responsibilities.

- a. Student Technology and Campus Services Advisory Committee: The EVPFO shall be responsible for establishing and co-chairing the Student Technology and Campus Services Advisory Committee (STACSAC). STACSAC shall exist to maintain a dialogue and working relationship between college administration and students regarding issues of technology and campus services on campus. The committee shall meet once per quad. Members shall include eight students selected by the EVPFO. Additionally, the Chief Information Officer, the Director of Technology Support Services, the Auxiliary Services Director, a Graduate School Council Representative, and the EVP of Student Life and Engagement will be invited to participate in the committee meetings.
- b. Reporting to the Student Government Board: The EVPFO shall make regular reports to Student Government regarding the activities accomplished since the last report, and activities to be accomplished before the next report is given. In addition, the EVPFO shall meet with the President and Vice President regularly.

D. Communication Responsibilities.

- a. The EVPFO shall establish and maintain relationships with members of the student body, faculty, and administration. Specific relationships are as follows:
 - i. Representation to the Faculty.
 - 1. The Faculty Business Meeting. The EVPFO shall be responsible for

- attending all faculty business meetings.
- 2. Technology and Information Resources Committee. The EVPFO shall sit on the TIR Committee.
- ii. Representation to the Administration and Board of Trustees. 1. The EVPFO shall establish and maintain relationships with those on the College Staff and Administration who work in the finance division of the college. S/He shall also serve as the student representative to the Finance Committee of the Board of Trustees.
